Gladstone Region Program Database



The Program Database is a shared resource designed by the social service sector making it easier for practitioners and professionals across the human service sector to access information about local programs and services, for better-informed, quality referrals.

The database provides centralised access to program information including eligibility criteria, referral pathway, capacity, and the best point of contact to enable referrers to ensure that their clients receive the best possible support.

The user guide will support your experience and navigation of the Program Database, including:

- ➔ Search program information to match client need
- ➔ Add/update program information to improve the database quality and enable others to refer to your service
- ➔ Contribute feedback for continuous improvement.

By using the database, you're contributing to a stronger, more connected service system that benefits the Gladstone Region community we serve.

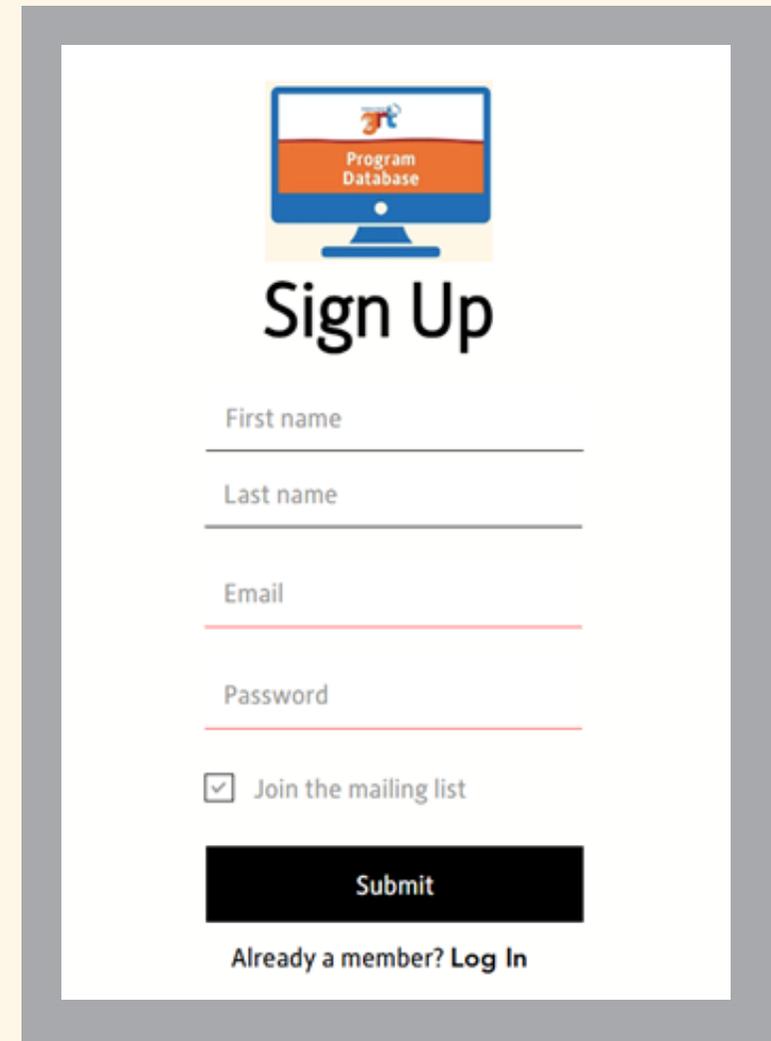


Access the Program Database

2 Sign Up by entering a login (your unique email address) and create a password. A 6-digit number will be emailed to you to verify your email address.

Tips to Navigate the Program Database

Simplify Your Search

1 Use filters to view program information that matches your client's need.

2 Or search by Organisation to see all programs offered.

3 To reset all selections, click 'Clear All Filters.'

Select Filters: All filters are optional. Selections will automatically filter the results.

Database Format



The Program Database follows a consistent format. Where there are blank spaces in the database, it can be assumed there is no restrictive criteria in this space. For example, a blank cell when viewing the column 'Eligibility Requirement Age' indicates the program is accessible to people of all ages.

The Program Database responds to the need for improved access to program referral information, consistently identified as a priority across local social, health and education sectors, and is designed to complement existing directories, avoid duplication, and pave the way to longer-term optimisation of local efforts in enabling effective referrals.
